VII. FEE CLARIFICATION

ITEM #17, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or premanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION TOTAL FEES MUST INCLUDE PROPER NUMBER OF INSPECTIONS

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Keweenaw County Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number. If you have any questions, please contact the following inspector:

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND/OR CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.**
